
 - Fewer cars driving --> quicker line for those who have no other option fewer emissions (~9kg of CO₂ per gallon of gas) more time for you!

EMS PTSA Enrichment Program

For the 2023-2024 school year, EMS PTSA has offered 10 enrichment programs to the EMS families. School staff, parents/guardians and local learning communities partner together to support students' achievement.

- **Robotics Club:** First tournament a huge success. Thank you to all the volunteers!
- Math Club: Math Club organized Mathcounts School round, AMC 10 & AMC 8 Tournaments. Mathcounts Chapter Round is scheduled 2/3 & Math Is Cool is scheduled on 2/10.
- Coding Club: 30+ students are regular participants; many parents have reached out to share their positive experience with Coding Club. Coding Club Tournament season has not year started
- **NSB (National Science Bowl) Club:** 3 teams from EMS have been registered. The teams will be participating in the regional event on 2/3.
- SO (Science Olympiad) club: 2 Teams from EMS have registered for the Washington Science Olympiad. EMS teams took 1st place and 3rd place at the most recent in-person invitational. Teams are prepping for Regionals on 3/9.
- **Theater Club:** Along with Studio East's ArtReach program, EMS PTSA is excited to bring *Ready Player Wonderland* to the stage March 2-3.
- **Reflections:** 3 Evergreen students' original works of art have advanced to Washington State PTA judging in this year's Reflections program! These three artists earned some of the highest rankings out of more than 320 entries from 39 district PTSAs and PTAs in the Lake Washington PTSA Council level of competition.
- **Spelling Bee:** Qualifying round is happening Thursday, January 25th from 2:30-3:30. More information on our website <u>www.evergreenptsa.org</u>
