PRESIDENTIAL SERVICE AWARDS

Any student age 5 and above can earn the Presidential Service Award. The award is given for three levels of service:

50+ hours - Bronze award

75+ hours - Silver award

100+ hours - Gold award

Many Evergreen students participate in activities that support the local community, whether it is through school, church, Scouts or other areas of the community. Evergreen Staff and PTSA would like to recognize those students who regularly incorporate community service into their schedules.

How are community service hours tracked? Each student is responsible for tracking and getting confirmation, if needed, of their own hours. Hours are to be completed between June 1st to May 31st. An announcement will be made late April / early May so students know deadline. The announcement will also be made on the Volunteer Opps PowerSchool page. *Best recommendation – start a file now so you are not scrambling at the end of the year. If you are also doing hours for NJHS, make a copy of your submission to NJHS before you hand it in so the teachers do not have to track it down later.*

What information is needed in order to submit hours? Application cover sheet. Summary of hours including dates, projects, total hours, confirmation if more than 2 cumulative hours for one activity.

How do I get confirmation of hours? Any community service projects that are reported for more than 2 cumulative hours must have confirmation of the total number of hours. Please have the form below signed by someone who witnessed the hours (preferably someone other than your parent) and turn it in when all hours are requested in. Extra forms will be available on the PTSA website.

Examples of projects: WEB Leaders, Student led ASB activities, lemonade stands/bake sales when the money collected is donated to charity, food drives, feeding the homeless, volunteering at church or with your Scout troop.
